

Notice for Other State Quota Applicants – Counselling under Supernumerary - UG - Admissions 2025-26 RGUKT

Dear Applicants (Application under Other state quota – except AP)

All students who have applied under the Other State Quota (i.e., those who have studied outside the state of Andhra Pradesh) are hereby informed to attend the selection process for admission under Supernumerary Quota seats for all four campuses. Your admission is subject to verification of all original certificates at the time of counselling, which will be held at the **RGUKT - R K Valley campus on 17-Jul-2025**.

Therefore, you are required to attend the counselling at **RGUKT R K Valley campus** at 8:00 A.M. on **17-Jul-2025** with all the documents mentioned below for selection process for all four campuses.

Admission will be confirmed only after verification of your academic and category original certificates at the time of counselling. Your provisional admission will be held based on the number of applicants attended.

Documents to be brought for counselling (Two Sets of photocopies along with the original documents for verification)

- 1. Grade/marks sheet of 10th Class Board Examination (Other than Andhra Pradesh)
- 2. Study Certificates
- 3. Resident Certificates
- 4. Four photographs of the candidate and parents (father & mother)
- 5. Aadhar Cards of the candidate, father and mother

Candidates admitted under other state quota are not eligible for scholarship and required to pay full tuition fee as mentioned below. Tuition Fee is Rs. 1,50,000/- per year. Students need to pay the fee at the beginning of each academic year for all six years.

At the time of counselling, candidates need to pay the following fee

- I. PUC first year Tuition Fee of Rs. 1,50,000/-
- II. Admission fee of Rs.1,000/- (Rs.500/- for SC/ST candidates) by all,
- III. Rs.1200/- towards group insurance (by all) (to be paid to the insurance agency by the University)
- IV. Refundable caution deposit of Rs.1,000 (by all),
- V. One time hostel maintenance charges of Rs.1000/- (by all)

A Total of Rs.154,200/- (Rs 153,700/- in case of SC/ST candidates)

Important points to be noted by the admitted candidates:

- 1. The first year of PUC batches from the Ongole and Srikakulam campus will be accommodated in prefabs at the RGUKT Nuzvid campus. RGUKT may change these internal arrangements as per the requirement from time to time.
- 2. Since RGUKT is a completely residential university, students seeking admission and their parents are advised to note that attendance is compulsory, and there will not be any provision for condonation except on justifiable medical grounds.
- 3. There is an exit option available to students after two years of the PUC program. They can join elsewhere only after satisfying all the academic requirements according to RGUKT guidelines. RGUKT follows a multidisciplinary approach; therefore, elementary biology is compulsory in the PUC program. Passing biology is necessary, although grades in biology are not used for branch allocation or to calculate the CGPA.
- 4. Engineering branches will be allotted based on merit in the PUC, following the reservation rules as per AP State Government norms. The availability of engineering seats in various branches will be displayed at the time of allotment, and students must abide by that. The institute's discretion in this matter is final.
- 5. Under no circumstances is the internal transfer of candidates between campuses permitted. Students must study at the campus where they are admitted.
- 6. Candidates admitted under other state quota are not eligible for scholarship and required to pay full tuition fee as mentioned. Tuition Fee is Rs. 1,50,000/- per year. Students need to pay the fee at the beginning of each academic year for all six years.
- 7. Candidates must pay the actual monthly mess charges to the university (approximately Rs.3,000/- per month).
- 8. As a part of skill up gradation, RGUKT has signed an MoU with ISB Hyderabad for collaboration. Interested students need to pay a nominal contribution of Rs.5,000/- (one-time) towards this.
- 9. In view of the National Education Policy 2020, RGUKT has modularized the six-year integrated B.Tech program. The university will award a certificate (title of the certificate to be decided) with 40 credits after completing the first year of B.Tech, a diploma in the respective branch of engineering after completing the 2nd year of B.Tech with 80 credits, and a degree after four years of B.Tech. Furthermore, RGUKT is also planning to offer a B.Tech honors/minor degree (after grouping courses) with an additional 20 credits.
- 10. All students must strictly follow the academic regulations and hostel rules of the university. Smoking and consumption of any intoxicants or drugs are totally prohibited, and will lead to immediate dismissal from the University.
- 11. Ragging in any form is totally banned and is punishable as per the Government Order. If any student is found to be indulging in any sort of ragging or harassment to juniors or other fellow students, inside or outside the campus, hostel, he/she will be dismissed immediately from the University, and criminal action will be taken against them as per the rules.
- 12. All the students need to follow the academic regulations and hostel rules of the University strictly.
